Pink Shirt Day - February 28th, 2024

 Pink Shirt Day - Participants wear pink shirts to raise awareness about bullying in schools, workplaces, at home, and online. The initiative began in Canada in 2007, when Grade 12 students in Cambridge, Nova Scotia, bought and distributed 50 pink shirts after a fellow student was bullied for wearing a pink shirt.
