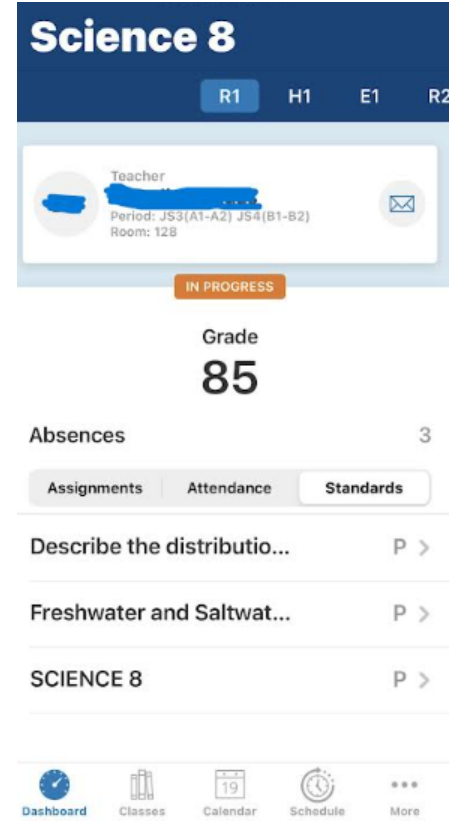
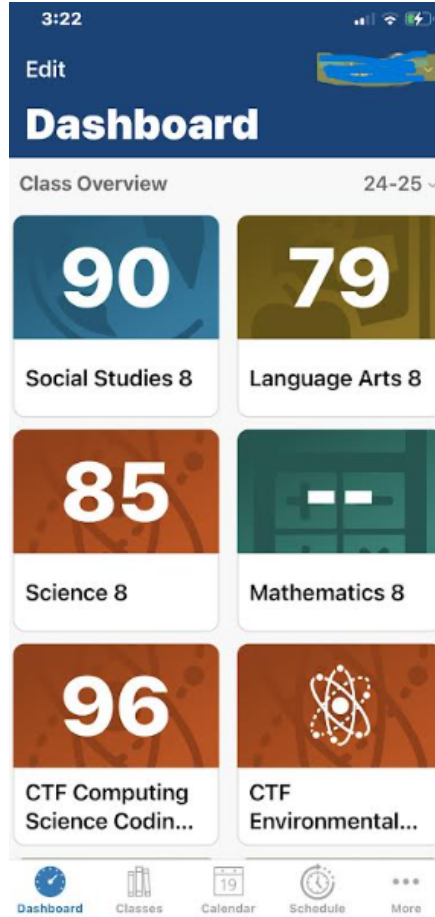

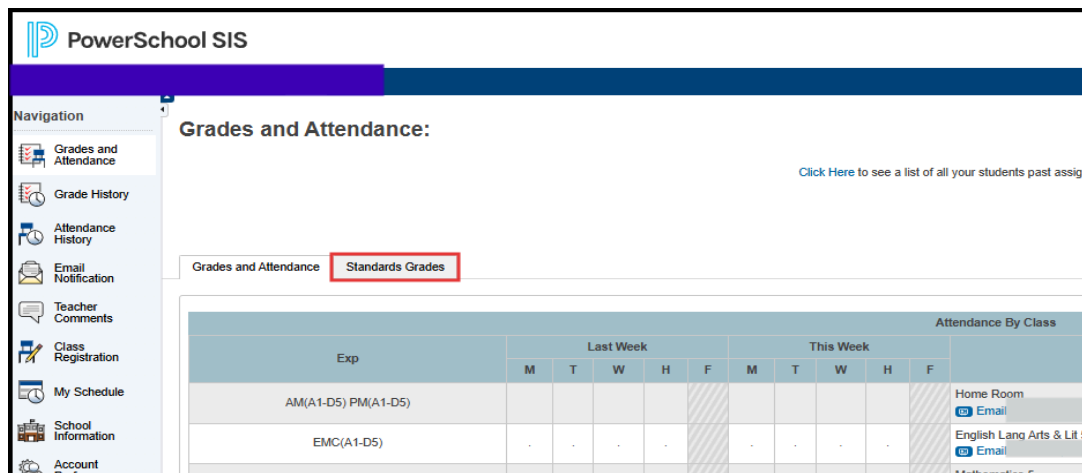


1. Click on the app.




